School is Off to a Great Start!!

Thanks for helping get the school year off to a great start. Here are some reminders about general questions you may have:

- ◇ When can I talk to my child's teacher? Teachers will be available every day from 3:15—3:30. We invite you drop in to talk to them after dismissal time. You may always call ahead to arrange a specific time to talk for a more formal conference.
- ◇ Can I come to my child's classroom? We welcome parents to come and sit in or assist the teacher but you must make arrangements with the teacher for an extended visit or if you wish to assist in the classroom. If you just want to drop in for a few minutes, simply come to the front office and request a classroom visit. Please remember that this is instructional time and the teacher will not be able to conference with you during your visit.
- ◇ How will dismissal take place on extremely hot/rainy days? Dismissal will take place inside from the classrooms on specific days. Parents will need to enter through the main lobby and get a badge to proceed to their child's classroom.
- ◇ How can I help make the dismissal process more efficient and safer? When driving through, a) Have your ID ready, b) Remember to pull forward, c) Stay in your car, d) Move car seats to the left side of your vehicle so that students may enter from the passenger side.
- ◇ Can I walk in and pick up my child from the dismissal line? If you walk up to the dismissal line to pick up your child, a) Please do not motion for your child to come to you; b) Wait until there is an appropriate time for the teacher to sign out your child. c) Have your ID ready. d) Do not use this time to talk with the teacher who must give all of their attention to the dismissal process.
